
ORDINANCE #32

WHEREAS, the Pennington County, South Dakota, Board of County Commissioners deems it necessary for the purpose of promoting safety and general welfare of the community to adopt an ordinance so no person shall push, pile, dump, place, or in any fashion dispose of snow on any County or public highway, road, or right-of-way. A violation of this section shall result in a maximum fine of \$50.00.

The party or parties involved shall be responsible for the removal of the snow. If Pennington County is required to remove the snow, it will be at a cost of \$60.00 per hour. The cost and expenses of these protective operations will be billed to the individual responsible. If these costs and expenses are not paid to the Pennington County Treasurer by October 1st of the incurring year, the sum will be extended onto the tax list against the landowner of the described property.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Pennington County Board of Commissioners adopt the foregoing ordinance. Dated this 5th day of December, 1995.
